

- -We continue to uphold our Incumbent, Bishop Michael Bird, in our prayers following his recent heart attack. Bishop Michael will be away from active ministry for approximately one month as he takes necessary time to recover. In case of pastoral emergencies during this time, please contact Rev. Matthew or Rev. Gillian at 613-687-9123. Rev. Matthew and Rev. Gillian will ensure that either they or another member of our Valley clergy team respond in a timely manner.
- -The Parish of the Valley extends its condolences to the Lethbridge family. The Reverend Canon David Lethbridge, honourary assistant and long-time parishioner, died last week. His funeral was held on Wednesday, April 20th. Our prayers are with Phyllis and their entire family.
- -Bishop Shane Parker is pleased to announce that the Rev. Rick Durrett will once again be joining our Parish of the Valley clergy team as an Interim Associate Priest, effective Sunday May 1st. Similar to Canon John Wilker-Blakley, Rev. Rick will serve our parish for approximately two days per week through to the end of Rev. Gillian's upcoming maternity leave. Rev. Rick will primarily be offering leadership in the Stafford-Whitewater region of our parish, as well as occasionally leading worship at Holy Trinity Pembroke. Rev. Matthew will continue offering primary leadership in Pembroke, while also offering pastoral and liturgical support to the congregations of Alice and Petawawa throughout Rev. Gillian's upcoming leave, in concert with our parish's lay readers and retired clergy.
- -Bishop Shane Parker is also pleased to announce the appointment of the Venerable Patrick Stephens, Incumbent of the Parish of St. Barnabas, Deep River, as the new Territorial Archdeacon for the Deanery of Pembroke, effective April 1st. Archdeacon Patrick succeeds Bishop Michael Bird in this diocesan role.
