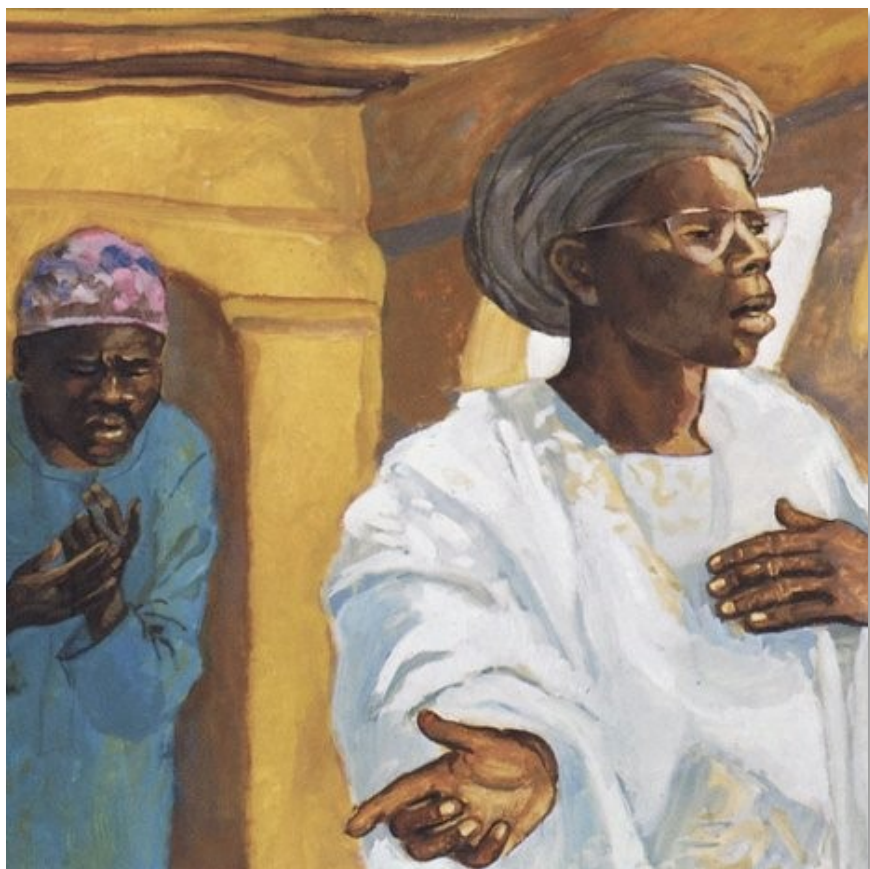

- † The history of Settler arrival, and their relationship to one another; and
- † The concepts of Terra Nullius (empty land) and the Doctrine of Discovery.

This is a wonderful opportunity to listen, learn, and engage in both the personal and collective journey toward a just, respectful and healing relationship between Indigenous Peoples and Settlers.
